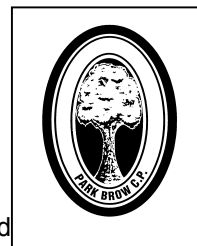


PARK BROW COMMUNITY PRIMARY SCHOOL

Sport Premium Policy



Principles

- We ensure that teaching and learning opportunities meet the needs of all of pupils including developing a love of Sport.
- We ensure that appropriate provision is made for Pupils to access a wide variety of sporting activities.
- We ensure that Staff receive appropriate professional development to enhance Sport in the curriculum.
- We ensure that Pupils have access to high quality coaching in a variety of Sports.
- We ensure that Sport contributes to our Pupils mental health and well being.
- Sport premium funding will be allocated following a needs analysis which will identify priority groups or individuals.

All our work through the Sport Premium will be aimed at enhancing the opportunities of our pupils to participate and develop a love of a variety of Sports. We have achieved the Sainsbury Schools Gold Award for two years and achieved an award at the Knowsley Sports Award for our commitment and achievement in Sport.

Sport Premium Grant Allocation for 2016/17 is £9,500.

Park Brow School has targeted the Sport Premium to:

- a) Participate in Knowsley's Swimming Delivery Plan this will ensure Pupil's receive a swimming program from Years 2 – 6 including catch up lessons during the Summer Term. These swimming sessions will be delivered by accredited swimming teachers. £1000.
- b) Participate in Knowsley's School Sports Partnership to enable our school to access competitive sport across Knowsley. £850
- c) Participate in Knowsley's Traded Service – Sports, Physical Activity and Arts and Heritage to provide a regular timetable during and after school Sports Provision and to enhance physical fitness throughout the lunch hour. £4680.
- d) Participate in Knowsley's Extended Services to ensure access to after school and holiday sports provision. £3000.
- e) To provide financial support to Parents whose children show a talent in a Sport and where the school provides coaching sessions. £200
- f) Staff Professional development as directed by a needs analysis £1,440 (Gymnastics 2015/16).
- g) To provide a wide variety of sporting opportunities including Judo, Fencing, Golf etc. (included in expenditure d)
- h) To release HLTA to deliver a Sports Fundamental Program at Key Stage 1. £500.
- i) Use of School minibus to access competitions. £50.
